2016 Vietti *Brunate* Barolo DOCG

Very layered and tannic with dried-strawberry, cedar and chocolate aromas and flavors. It's full-bodied, yet so balanced and pretty. Tight, yet creamy texture, making it so approachable. Better than the 2015. Better after 2023.



2016 Vietti *Ravera* Barolo DOCG

97 pts

The purity of fruit here is really something, offering aromas and flavors of crushed strawberries and raspberries. It's full-bodied with chewy tannins that are polished and refined. Love the finesse and strength to this. Yet, what makes this so attractive is the harmony and polish. Better than the 2015. Almost drinkable now. Better after 2022.



2016 Vietti *Rocche di Castiglione* Barolo DOCG

96 pts

Aromas of blueberries, sliced strawberries and peaches. Full body and firm, chewy tannins that are polished and velvety in a refined way. Better after 2022.



2016 Vietti *Castiglione* Barolo DOCG

95 pts

Tight and focused with racy, fine tannins. I like the bright fruit and vivid acidity. Cedar, berry and white-truffle flavors. Tight and linear. Needs time to open. Try after 2022.



2016 Vietti *Masseria Barbaresco* DOCG

94 pts

Mushrooms and juicy fruit with chewy yet ripe tannins. Medium to full body. Flavorful finish. Shows richness and balance. Really fine tannins. Try after 2022.



2016 Vietti *Lazzarito* Barolo DOCG

94 pts

Very complex aromas of dried strawberries, fresh mushrooms and some sour cherries. It's full-bodied, yet tight and extremely tannic, yet ever so fine and polished. Wonderful length. Strength with finesse for a young Barolo. Better after 2022.
