Sweet floral notes meld into red berries, spices and mint in a supple, highly expressive Barbera that captures the essence of Alba in its juiciness. All the elements fall into place. 2011	Vietti	Barbera D'asti Tre Vigne	The 2011 Barbera d'Asti Tre Vigne is dark supple and generous, with fewer of the angular edges typical of this wine, largely the result of the warm year. 2011	Vietti	Barbera D'alba Vigna Scarrone	The 2011 Barbera d'Alba Scarrone Vigna Vecchia is drop-dead gorgeous. Powerful, rich and intense, the 2011 flows across the palate with layers of dark, mineral-infused fruit. Smoke, tar and licorice all flesh out in a Barbera that impresses for its pure drive and pedigree. 2011	Vietti	Barbera D'alba Scarrone Vigna Vecchia	The old-vine 2011 Barbera d'Alba Scarrone Vigna Vecchia is richer and more intense than the straight Scarrone Barbera, but not meaningfully different in this vintage. Blackberry jam, tar, smoke, French oak and leather all flesh out in a huge, voluptuous wine endowed with striking depth and tons of pure energy. In 2011, Vietti's two Barberas from Scarrone aren't as different as they often are. I am not sure of that is a function of the vintage, or if as the vineyards get older, the differences between the parcels become less pronounced.
