



### 2014 Vietti "Tre Vigne" Barbera di Asti, Piedmont, Italy

Medium to dark garnet in the glass, this wine smells of cherries, cedar, and dried orange peels. In the mouth, beautifully bright orange peel and cherry flavors mix with a gorgeous dried herb and an alfalfa note that zings with the same brightness of the fruit thanks to excellent acidity. Gorgeously smooth tannins pull taut across the palate, offering a very refined expression of this sometimes youthfully gruff grape. Outstanding. 13.5% alcohol. Score: between 9 and 9.5.



### 2013 Vietti "Perbacco" Nebbiolo, Lange, Piedmont, Italy

Medium ruby in the glass, this wine smells of rose petals and red berries. In the mouth, very pretty rose and strawberry flavors mix with a hint of road tar and woodsmoke. Gorgeously bright acidity makes the wine quite refreshing as notes of sour cherry emerge on the finish along with tacky tannins. Lovely. 13.5% alcohol. Score: around 9.
